

Integrity and Relationships

Text: Matthew 5:33-48

Matt. 5:33 ¶ “Again you have heard that it was said to those of old, ‘You shall not swear falsely, but shall perform your oaths to the Lord.’

Matt. 5:34 But I say to you, do not swear at all: neither by heaven, for it is God’s throne;

Matt. 5:35 nor by the earth, for it is His footstool; nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King.

Matt. 5:36 Nor shall you swear by your head, because you cannot make one hair white or black.

Matt. 5:37 But let your “Yes’ be “Yes,’ and your “No,’ ‘No.’ For whatever is more than these is from the evil one.

Matt. 5:38 ¶ “You have heard that it was said, ‘*An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth.*’

Matt. 5:48 Therefore you shall be perfect, just as your Father in heaven is perfect. [Striving toward perfection]

Psa. 7:8 The LORD shall judge the peoples;
 Judge me, O LORD, according to my righteousness,
 And according to my **integrity** within me.

Psa. 51:2 Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, And **cleanse me from my sin.**

Job 31:6 Let me be weighed on honest scales,

That God may know my **integrity**.

Matt. 5:38 ¶ “You have heard that it was said, ‘*An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth.*’

Psa. 25:21 Let **integrity** and uprightness preserve me,
For I wait for You.

Psa. 26:1 ¶ Vindicate me, O LORD,
For I have walked in my **integrity**.
I have also trusted in the LORD;
I shall not slip.

Psa. 26:11 But as for me, I will walk in my **integrity**;
Redeem me and be merciful to me.

Psa. 41:12 As for me, You uphold me in my **integrity**,
And set me before Your face forever.

Psa. 78:72 So he shepherded them according to the **integrity** of his
heart,
And guided them by the skillfulness of his hands.

Prov. 10:9 He who walks with **integrity** walks securely,
But he who perverts his ways will become known.

Prov. 11:3 The **integrity** of the upright will guide them,
But the perversity of the unfaithful will destroy them.

Prov. 19:1 Better *is* the poor who walks in his **integrity**
Than *one who is* perverse in his lips, and is a fool.

Prov. 20:7 The righteous *man* walks in his **integrity**;
His children *are* blessed after him.

Prov. 28:6 Better *is* the poor who walks in his **integrity**
Than one perverse *in his* ways, though he *be* rich.

Titus 2:7 in all things showing yourself *to be* a pattern of good works; in doctrine
showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility,
